Notes:

1.	Paul Renowden was invited to help define what educational issues should be addressed by the Neighbourhood Plan.	
2.	Initial comments included: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Schools are no longer assessed with regard to the need for facilities, such as school halls. Assessment is primarily focussed on maintenance needs. There is no budget for school improvements. The current expansion area identified for Penpol is 0.7ha. This would provide 2-form entry. With 1600 dwellings at a 1:9 ratio for both primary and secondary gives 120 places at Bodriggy and 90 at Penpol. An allocation of about 2.6ha would be needed at Penpol to provide for 3-form entry. Guidance on required area is given in BB103 Area Guidelines for Mainstream Schools, 25/06/14. Hayle Community School is currently not under pressure and has around 229 potential places. 	
3.	After discussion it was agreed: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> We will allocate about 2.6ha around Penpol School to be protected for either a replacement school or a larger extension (3-form entry). We will allocate the area proposed by AECOM for a new primary school at Trevassack 	NP
4.	Paul Renowden will send us a note providing an evidence basis for allocating the additional space around Penpol.	PR
